**BYLAW FOR STANDING COMMITTEE REPORTING STRUCTURE**

*Purpose to be achieved and reasons supporting the change (ADP Bylaws Article XII, Section 2 B)*

Arizona Democrat Party delegates deserve to know what their Executive Board is doing. We hear nothing from the Special Committees appointed by the Chair. We don't know what their tasks are and who serves on these committees, if or when they meet or what they are accomplishing. We've heard rumors about a Progressive, Administrative and Technology Committee; but we do not know what their task is. Committee appointments must be made public, members must be held accountable and performance and progress must be measured! In the interest of transparency and accountability, we propose the following addition to the bylaws:

**ARTICLE VI. OTHER COMMITTEES, Section 2.**

**DUTIES OF OFFICERS AND MEMBERS ASSIGNED TO STANDING COMMITTEES**

The Executive Board will report to Arizona Democratic Party delegates, at State Committee meetings, with Committee Chairs reporting information on the tasks and accomplishments of the committees on which they serve. Committee membership will be made available to Arizona Democrats upon request. Standing and Other Committees meetings schedules will be posted on the ADP website.
